Engineering	Engineering does not meet the requirements of 23-1-108(7) which states that statewide transfer articulation agreements are between degree programs. There are many types of engineering degrees (e.g., Petroleum Engineer, Civil Engineer, Chemical Engineer). This agreement covers them all and so varies widely depending on which 4-year IHE the student transfers into and which type of engineering degree she/he chooses.
