

At its June 4<sup>th</sup> meeting, the Colorado Commission on Higher Education approved extensions to June 30, 2011, for all institutions with performance contracts with an expiration date of June 30, 2009. The attached amendment will extend the University of Colorado's performance contract to June 30, 2011.

As you now, the extension is intended to maintain the status quo while the Commission carries out a strategic planning effort over the next 16 months and enables the results of that effort to be reflected in possible revisions to the performance contracts that may need to be negotiated. The extension will also permit us to accommodate any statutory changes that may occur during the 2011 legislative session.

#### 1. PARTIES

THIS CONTRACT AMENDMENT NO. 1 (hereinafter called this "Amendment") to the Performance Contract entered into by and between the Department of Higher Education (hereinafter referred to as the "Department") and the Regents of the University of Colorado for (hereinafter the "Original Contract"), made this 8th day of June, 2009, is entered into by and between the Department and the Board of Regents of the University of Colorado (hereinafter called "Governing Board").

#### 2. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE AND ENFORCEABILITY</u>

This Amendment shall be effective and enforceable upon signature of the parties (hereinafter its "Effective Date") and upon review and approval by the Colorado Commission of Higher Education, in accordance with its provisions. The Department shall not be liable to pay or reimburse the Governing Board for any performance hereunder, including, but not limited to, costs or expenses incurred, or be bound by any provision hereof prior to the Effective Date.

#### 3. FACTUAL RECITALS

The Parties entered into the Original Contract, made on April 7, 2005, in order to comply with the statutory requirements of the College Opportunity Fund Act, Title 23, Article 18, Section 101 et seq.

#### 4. CONSIDERATION

Consideration for this Amendment consists of the payments to be made hereunder and the obligations, promises, and agreements herein set forth.

#### 5. LIMITS OF EFFECT

This Amendment is incorporated by reference into the Original Contract, and the Original Contract and all prior amendments thereto, if any, remain in full force and effect except as specifically modified herein.

#### 6. <u>MODIFICATIONS</u>

The Original Contract and all prior amendments thereto, if any, are modified as follows:

A. Section 2 of the Original Contract is amended to extend the Term of this contract by eighteen months, with the new termination date to be on June 30, 2011.

#### 7. ORDER OF PRECEDENCE

In the event of any conflict, inconsistency, variance, or contradiction between the provisions of this Amendment and any of the provisions of the Original Contract, the provisions of this Amendment shall in all respects supersede, govern, and control.

## 8. **AVAILABLE FUNDS**

Financial obligations of the State payable after the current fiscal year are contingent upon funds for that purpose being appropriated, budgeted, or otherwise made available.
